TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE SECRETARY OF STATE hereby gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up and diversion of a length of Bridleway no. MR10 and public right of way MR29 and the stopping up of a length of public right of way no. MR15; 6 lengths of Hall Road; 3 lengths of Old Church Road; and a length of Court Road at the Parishes of Wouldham and Burham in the Borough of Tonbridge and Malling and Rochester, Medway.

IF THE ORDER IS MADE, the stopping up will be authorised only in order to enable development as permitted by Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council, under references TM/05/00989/OAEA, TM/05/00990/FLEA, TM/07/00436/RD, TM/07/03045/RM, TM/07/03042/RM, TM/13/03948/FL and as permitted by Medway Council under reference MC2005/0756.

COPIES OF THE DRAFT ORDER AND RELEVANT PLANS will be available for inspection during normal opening hours at Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council, Gibson Building, Gibson Drive, Kings Hill, West Malling, Kent, ME19 4LZ in the 28 days commencing on 17 October 2014, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the Secretary of State (quoting NATTRAN/SE/S247/1384) at the address stated below.
